A. Discussion Regarding the following Service Provider RFP Minimum Requirement (page 13, #1):

The firm must have at least five years experience administering Section 457 deferred compensation plans and must be currently administering a minimum of three governmental Section 457 plans each with assets of \$500 million or more, 10,000 participants or more, and multiple payroll centers.

Discussion regarding whether bidders are required to be currently administering a minimum of three governmental 457 plans wherein the bidders themselves administer at least \$500 million, 10,000 participants and multiple payroll centers, or whether the bidders are required to be currently administering a <u>portion</u> of three governmental 457 plans where each plan as a whole has at least \$500 million in assets, 10,000 participants and multiple payroll centers.

The Committee will be considering an amendment to the RFP, including a possible deadline extension.
